

The Fire Standards Board has been set up to oversee the identification, organisation, development and maintenance of professional Standards for fire and rescue services in England.


#### <u>Protection Fire Standard</u> issued on 3<sup>rd</sup> September 2021 includes Primary Authority

A Fire and Rescue Service must.... plan and deliver effective and robust protection activities to mitigate and reduce the risks identified through its community risk management planning in compliance with the **Regulator's Code** and the principles of **Better Regulation**;.... including:

- actively promoting and supporting **Primary Authority Partnership schemes** in compliance with relevant Primary Authority legislation,
- collaborate with fire and rescue services and other partners to deliver protection and enforcement activities in the most efficient and effective way possible;
